Below is a brief bio for Erika Malloy, our new Learn & Play Director. We're sharing it on our Learn & Play website so that current and prospective parents get to know our Director. Hello everyone! My name is Erika Malloy. I reside in North Haven with my husband Jimmie and our three beautiful children, ages 26, 17, and 10. Besides my bachelor degree in child studies, I received most of my early childhood experience at the Phyllis Bodel Childcare Center at Yale Medical School. I worked there as an infant/ toddler teacher for 12 years before being promoted to Assistant Program Coordinator. Upon leaving Phyllis Bodel, I moved on to be the Director at a childcare center in New Haven for 3 years and then became the Director for a childcare center in Hamden, where I was for the last 3 years.
